

DRIVING SAFETY

PROMOTING A CULTURE OF SAFE DRIVING

Of all activities in our company, motor vehicle use has the greatest possibility of producing incidents that lead to death, and with an average of around 500,000km driven every month group-wide, they are ATS' **highest risk**.



REQUIREMENTS FOR DRIVING VEHICLES ON ATS OPERATIONS:

- Valid driver's licence and Defensive Driving Training;
- ATS & Client inductions, Write and pass the ATS Permit to Work as a Driver;
- Valid medical and fitness for work as a driver
- Report incidents and near misses immediately to ATS management;
- Must know ATS Driving Cardinal Rules; and
- Sign acknowledgement to comply with ATS alcohol and drugs restrictions



REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES ON ATS OPERATIONS:

- Inspected and approved fit for use before heading to site;
- Must be fitted with a vehicle tracking device;
- Valid registration, roadworthy paperwork and legal documentation;
- Must have all the required insurance cover;
- Up to date service and maintenance records; and
- ATS Driving Cardinal Rules pasted on the dashboard or windshield.



THE MAIN CAUSES OF VEHICLE INCIDENTS IN ATS:

- Faulty vehicles or vehicles that do not meet the required standard;
- Fatigue from night shifts, long shifts, long journeys or drivers not getting enough rest;
- Driver negligence, over speeding, reckless driving and failure to wear seat belts;
- Lack of Training, Failure to observe ATS, Client or National road safety rules;
- Intoxication (Drugs and Alcohol); and
- Inadequate incident investigations and failure to learn from previous incidents.



HOW DO MOTOR VEHICLE INCIDENTS AFFECT US IN ATS?

- Injuries and Fatalities – People have died, plus injuries, serious or minor cause loss of valuable production time
- Impact on Family – When someone is hurt at work, their families are also affected;
- Loss of Reputation and Trust with Clients and the Community – Leads to loss of good standing/ possible loss of business;
- Liabilities Incurred – Property/vehicle damage as well as injuries/fatalities to third parties;
- Money lost in repairs and increase in insurance – Damage to infrastructure and vehicles; and
- Downtime lost on vehicles – Unscheduled repairs and maintenance.



THE ATS DRIVING CARDINAL RULES

- Rules meant to prevent the main causes of motor vehicle incidents in ATS;
- First Rule:** Be Sober – No alcohol or drugs when driving;
- Second Rule:** Do Vehicle Pre-Start Check – Before every shift and keep the records;
- Third Rule:** No Seatbelt, No Seat, No Ride – Vehicle cannot move until everyone has seatbelts on;
- Fourth Rule:** No Reversing without a Spotter – Know your surroundings before reversing;
- Fifth Rule:** Park and Double Chock - Park, handbrake on, switch off engine & apply double chocks.
